

The "Big Blockade"

Jamie has lodged a motion in the Parliament supporting the "Big Blockade" event he attended earlier this month. The motion reads:

That the Parliament congratulates the organisers of the Faslane 365 campaign on their year of activity at the Faslane nuclear submarine base, particularly for their efforts on 1 October 2007 with their Big Blockade; reiterates its position against renewal of the UK nuclear deterrent expressed in motion S3M-169, as passed on 14 June 2007; notes the strength of opinion against nuclear weapons across Scotland, and believes that no nuclear weapons should be stored, harboured or transported on Scottish soil or waters.

The Scottish Parliament has voted against the renewal of the Trident nuclear weapons system. On 22nd October, the Scottish Government organised a summit to discuss nuclear disarmament. Also, a majority of Scottish members of the Westminster parliament have expressed their opposition to the renewal of Trident.
